- Every trip abroad during the last 5 years (dates of departure, arrival, and destinations);
- If you receive any public benefits (MassHealth, SNAP, etc.), you can apply for a fee waiver;
- If you're low income, you may qualify for a fee reduction; (please bring your last filed tax return)
- If you're married:
 - Spouse's full name
 - Spouse's date of birth
 - Marriage date
 - Spouse's Social Security number
 - Spouse's full address
 - Spouse's Green Card number (if any)
 - Marriage Certificate

- Naturalization/ Birth Certificate of spouse who is an american citizen (if you obtained your Green Card through marriage, and are applying after 3 years)
